### "~~promoting~~ the interests of the hobby"

*Over the years, since 1970 actually, MAAC has worked behind the scenes to protect the interests of the hobbyists against legislation that could have had a negative impact on driving our collector vehicles. MAAC has also worked proactively to make changes the way we register our antiques or collector cars. Some of the areas MAAC has made specific impact on behalf of the entire hobby are:*

- *Year of Manufacture Plate wording drafted, approved & implemented by RMV.*
- *Initiated Insurance Law changes to allow Specialty Insurance Carriers to write Agreed Value policies in Massachusetts.*
- *Seatbelt law that exempts vehicles manufactured before 1966 to be retro-fitted.*
- *Vehicle inspection program to exempt antique vehicles from any type of emission testing & waiver from annual inspection if vehicle is off road for an extended period.*
- *Assistance in changing town zoning ordinances impacting storage of antiques on private property.*
- *Joining forces with the SEMA Action Network, worked toward passage of the Street Rod and Custom Car Registration Bill in 2010.*
- *Fought against repeated attempts to ban after-market exhaust systems and unenforceable exhaust noise testing.*

Don't sit back and assume that somebody-else is 'looking out' for you and your automotive hobby in Massachusetts. *There are over 100 auto hobbyist clubs and many thousands of auto enthusiasts in our state of Massachusetts but ONLY ONE association* that is involved in the auto hobby with the only purpose to 'Protect our Interests'.

*MAAC cannot stand still. To make all this happen, the association needs your support - attend our next meeting and learn how you can become involved. Please make sure "your club is a member" and the 2011 dues are paid !!!*
